My dear Mr. Jowett:

It gives me great pleasure to inform you that the Board of Directors of the College have decided to approve your courses of study, and give your students recognition for the work done with you.

This means that if a student completes one of your courses, and wishes to enroll for a course of study with the College, with the intention of becoming a physical director and receiving the Diploma, "Bachelor of Physical Education", he will be given credit on our course for the work done with you.
