Corporal Howard McManus, of the Norfolk Regiment, who was reported killed, is a prisoner of war at Stenlager, H. Bei Paderborn, Germany: "I am writing," he says, "as a member of your 'H. & S.' League. I should like to hear from any member of the League. I have been wounded, but am getting on well now. I am Howard Carlyle, of the Three Carlyles, equilibrists. We have concerts here amongst ourselves, and I have plenty of practice with Fred Gwyn, another music-hall artiste, also Monsieur Le Garo, a French hand balancer. 5-22-1915"
