

## The Club-Swinging Record.

East Hill, Westralia, Ferrier St., Rockdale,  
Sydney, N. S. Wales, Australia: In the issue of  
"H. & S." for June 10th, 1911, which is just to  
hand, there appeared in "H. & S." debating club  
column a letter from Harry Lewis with reference  
to the world's club-swinging record, in which he  
stated Tom Burrows' record swing of 76hr. 2min.  
had been beaten, and the record swing was  
80hr. 30min. On July 1st T. Burrows completed  
a swing of 84hr. 4min. at Cusinn, N.S.W., his pre-  
vious record of 76hr. having been beaten at West  
Maitland a few weeks previous. I am not sure  
who broke it, but it was brought up to 80hr. 20min.  
Since then Burrows' record has been broken by  
Harry Lawson at Kempsey, his swing being  
90hr. This swing was only completed on Sat-  
night. By this it will be seen that the record  
given by H. Lewis has been beaten by at least  
three men, one being Tom Burrows. I en-  
close two cuttings from the Sydney "Morning  
Herald" with reference to the swings of Bur-  
rows and Lawson, the former being July 4th and  
the latter July 15th.
